JUDGE DECLARES CJA 'DRACONIAN' AND UNLAWFUL

A community of travellers were celebrating an historic victory yesterday when a High Court judge declared the Criminal Justice Act 'Draconian' and unlawful.

Victory came as the Crowborough travellers successfully mounted the first legal challenge of an eviction order made under section 77 of the new Act. The test-case decision sets a new legal precedent and means all Councils must now fully investigate the needs of travellers, particularly women and children, their health and education before attempting an eviction. Wealdon District Council may appeal.

Over in the secluded 42-acre Phie Forest, an old army training ground in East Sussex, the travelling community could be found chanting "we have won! we have won! we have won!" About fifty people live on site, including a dozen young children. One said "It means this whole way of life will be looked at and thought about Another traveller was simply glad that "at last someone has understood". The Public Law Project took up the case on behalf of Tracey Foster, whose daughter Chelsea suffers from a serious medical condition. They fought the Judicial Review on the grounds that Council has a legal duty to safeguard and promote the welfare of children in need under the Children's Act. Jubilant spokes-man Ravi Lobier told SchNEWS: "We're over the moon, guv'nor!"

The Criminal Justice Act removed the statutory obligation to provide sites for travellers, repealing the 1968 Caravan Sites Act. Although vesterday's decision doesn't reverse this process it means in effect that all Councils must now seriously think about re-establishing a network of traditional sites. "The expense of court cases and investigation could prove too expensive, explained Steve Staines, of Friends, Families and Travellers Support Group, who hailed the court decision as "a victory for human rights.'

Judge Sedley summing up said "Wealdon Council had not made the proper enquiries about the humanitarian needs of the travellers before obtaining the removal order [and had not acted in] a compassionate manner". He added that the Act was "a Draconian piece of legislation". The ruling also means that eviction orders now only apply to those on the land when the order was made. Fresh applications must be made for all new arrivals.

A separate hearing concerning travellers in Lincolnshire was complicated by complaints of "nuisance" which were partially upheld. They could face eviction today but may appeal. Meanwhile it's back to the High Court on Monday for the Public Law Project to counter a case of 'rural fascism' in Cornwall.

Thirty travellers who have been living in Kerrier for five years put in a planning application to stay on the land, but the District Council want to evict before them before they get the chance to be heard. There's been no consultation and councillors have not even visited the site. In the light of the Crowborough decision, however, the case looks likely to be thrown straight out of court. Is this the dawning of a bright new day? After a summer season of demonised travellers caught on an eviction merry-goround, only time will tell.

RAMBLERS: ENEMIES OF THE STATE!

The 60-year-old Rambler's Association led a "rambling revolution" on Wednesday in defiance of the Criminal Justice Act. Ignoring barbed wire and 'Keep Out' notices they protested against exclusion from an area of the Pennine moor that has become the exclusive reserve of high-fee paying grouse shooters.

Frustrated by protracted negotiations the ramblers have declared a policy of "less talking and more walking". Chairwoman Kate Ashbrook stated: "This action follows successes in opening up hundreds of paths unlawfully obstructed by landowners. We are going to fight like never before to win back what should be a fundamental human right - the right to roam". The CJA makes trespass a criminal offence. A spokeswoman added: "Walkers and climbers could be affected as much as hunt saboteurs and we'll be closely monitoring the effects of the new law."

SAVETHE COURTHOUSE!

Beloved birthplace of a million dreams (and the SchNEWS), the Courthouse was squatted late last year as a meeting place for all those opposed to the Government's Criminal Justice Act plans. In just three days the derelict 100-yr-old former magistrates office was transformed into a thriving community centre with cafe, meditation space, crèche and free entertainment for a free people. Over 1,000 people a week came through the doors. Despite vowing in court to turn the building into a homeless hostel following the eviction it still remains empty, bricked-up and fortified. Now Guernseybased American owners Alford Developments have applied to rip it down and build yet more offices. In a poetic twist the Council will decide the fate of the Grade II listed building exactly a year to the day since it was re-opened to the public. SchNEWS IN BRIEF

Hundreds of Mancunians have been hit by a Poll Tax collection scandal. The desperate City Council, trying to recover a staggering £41 million in unpaid bills, hired agents who picked out names and address at random from phone books. One ineligible 14-year-old, Antony Wells, was threatened with the bailiffs for non-payment of £126.03! No need for debt enforcement now, of course. The Poll Tax has been replaced by the National Lottery- tax on the daft. Scratch-cards are now the UK's number one consumer item, outstripping Coca-Cola sales three to one *** The Conservative party have decided to do no more TV party political broadcasts for the time being. They discovered that support actually went down after their last two were broadcast! *** An unprovoked attack on a small group of travellers by site security on the opening night of the Guildford Folk and Blues Festival left one man with serious head injuries. The following night marauding security attacked the Guildford Hunt Sab stand leaving two needing treatment. In both instances police watched on and did not act. Infact one person was threatened with arrest while reporting the second incident, being told: "Go away or we'll nick you for obstruction". Complaints of widespread drunkenness, violence, drug dealing, ticket touting and sexual harassment by security were all accepted by the organisers off the record. However, in response to A live BBC radio report of the trouble the organisers insisted that the £27-a-ticket pay to play event was a total success, claiming the traveller's hospitalisation was due to his diabetic condition! Must've fallen over his insulin or something. "The police just watched - if this event had been a rave they'd have had the riot police in, " commented one angry reveller, Chris. *** Already hit by over 50 CJA arrests, road protestors in Kent are still standing defiant on the proposed route of the disastrous A299 Thanet Way. Last week 100 sheriff officers, security guards and police launched a dawn raid to evict the Clapham Hill site. Activists are now in the woodland - the last piece of land left to defend. The Institute for Social Inventions, a world-wide group with loads of famous patrons decides on the annual award *** Have you heard the one about the brave pigeon in Dover? Usual scenario: protesters, barrier, police, and a pigeon lands in the middle of the road, dodging traffic.
