* Why The Book, formerly known as the White Book? Well, if you really want to know, the White Book is both a legal and music biz directory, and it became the nickname of The Book. We asked some black organisations why they hadn't responded and were answered by looks of incredulity - we're stupid. We invited suggestions for new names, thanks to those of you who responded but nothing stuck, so The Book, why not - its only a name Hello Mum.

The Book is a directory that is an example of DIY production, and thus reflects the highs and lows of an enterprise run on humour, trust, honesty, adrenalin and seriously small amounts of money. What money we did have was spent on phone calls to Loch Mess and some of the worst posters in the history of printing. However, in spite, or perhaps because of the nature of its conception, The Book exists.

While the intention was to produce a definitive listing of campaign groups brought together by their opposition to the Criminal Justice Act (Bill), the interesting times in which we live in means that this book can only be a snapshot, a partial view. However, it is easily updated due to the wonders of technology, if you feel you or groups you know should be in it, photocopy the form in this book and send it to us.

The methodology of compiling the book was as chaotic as the times in which it was created. Every group we came into contact with, or had knowledge of, was sent a form - entirely different groups returned the forms - they speak for themselves. There are strange bedfellows like the Lesbian Avengers & Liberty. There are anomalies such as Worthing Against Motorways - SCAR - Alarm UK each of which is a sub-section of the other. We could be accused of a slight Southern bias, but this is only a draft copy - also there is no excuse for leaving your mates out.

Perhaps this will just turn out to be a historical document - many of the groups are barely a year old and they are consolidating. Maybe it is a directory of the foundations of a real movement, who knows, but in a sense the name of the groups are irrelevant - within these pages you have access to the individuals.

Most groups were born out of opposition to the Criminal Justice and Public Order Act 1994 and are united in resistance. But the successful positive direct action movement has made its first infant moves at setting the agenda to create a powerful alliance of thought facing the future. We are not talking about left/right or parliamentary politics. There is no revolutionary end-game. We are involved in a celebration as a struggle. This is about an empowerment of individuals paving the way for the next generation.

These are the people who are out there doing it - join them! From the Shetland Isles to the Isles of Wight - if there isn't a group - DO IT YOURSELF.

THE WORLD IS UNDER

The Criminal Justice and Public Order Act 1994 is a hot-potch of prejudices and an attack on basic human rights and freedoms by a paranoid and psychotic government. SchNEWSreader Gibby Zobel takes a look at the main parts of the 171 sections now law and the worst yet to come in Britain 1995 ...

1. TRAVELLERS

Local authorities no longer have to provide travellers with a site. It is now a criminal offence to camp after a local authority has asked them to leave. It is also a criminal offence not to leave land when asked to do so by a senior police officer if there has been damage to the land or if there are more than six vehicles on the land. Vehicles (read: homes) and can be confiscated and destroyed with travellers footing the bill. The police's Southern Intelligent Unit tracks travellers in 'Operation Snapshot' and has databased over 8,000 people.

Criminal Justice Act Section 61-62

2. RAVES

If an outdoor festival or rave has not been licensed the police can stop it. It is a criminal offence (with a maximum sentence of three months) if a person refuses to leave the site of such an event. New powers enable the police to confiscate soundsystem equipment. Police can also arrest someone whom they 'believe' is going within a 5-mile radius.

Criminal Justice Act Section 63-67

3. SQUATTERS

It is a criminal offence with a sentence of up to six months to occupy a squat for more than 24 hours after a landlord has gained an eviction order. It will also be possible for landlords or their 'representatives' to use violent entry into squats to gain repossession. Appeals can only be made after the eviction. A squatter has also been defined as someone who is behind in their rent.

Criminal Justice Act Section 72-76

4. HUNT SABOTEURS/PEACEFUL PROTEST /ROADBLOCKS

Trespass has been criminalised for the first time in British history. A new offence of 'aggravated trespass' means trespassers are now committing a criminal offence if they intend to disrupt a legal activity. It has been used to outlaw hunt saboteurs and anti-road

protestors but might easily be applied to trade union pickets or demonstrations outside foreign embassies.

Criminal Justice Act Section 68-69

5. BAN ON ASSEMBLIES

The Act also bans assemblies which are held on land without the permission of the owner and gives the police the power to stop people they suspect of travelling to such an assembly. This is aimed to stop Stonehenge gatherings and festivals but this could be used to ban animal rights demonstrations or even sit-down protests at football grounds. In April 1995 Essex police historically invoked the 1986 Public Order Act to try to ban demonstrations at Brightlingsea.

Criminal Justice Act Section 71

6. THE RIGHT TO SILENCE

Previously the prosecution could not draw conclusions from a person's choice to remain silent in police custody or as a defendant in a trial. After 400 years this is no longer the case. It puts the burden on defendants to prove their innocence rather than on the prosecution to prove their guilt. Section 48 encourages plea bargaining, leading to innocent people admitting to offences so as to guarantee a minimal sentence.

Criminal Justice Act Section 34-39

7. RIGHT TO BAIL

Instead of regarding pre-trial release as a natural consequence of presuming a defendant's innocence (six out of ten denied bail are acquitted) police can now set bail instead of an impartial magistrate. Imposing bail conditions is now a common tactic often used to ban individual protests from a specified area on threat of imprisonment.

Criminal Justice Act Section 27-30

8. CHILDREN'S PRISONS

At present offenders who are under 14 cannot be locked away except for very serious crimes. Five 'secure training centres', run privately, will house offenders between

the ages of 12 And 14 who have three or more convictions. A child can be forcibly strip-searched by a single member of staff with no one else present. All mail to and from a child can be read or censored. The director of the prison can stop all family visits whenever he wants. The Home Secretary has to give permission for a child to communicate with anyone.

Criminal Justice Act Part 1

9. DETENTION CAMPS & PRISON SHIPS

'Boot camps' - US-style military discipline 'shock incarceration' regimes - are being tried out. They demand parade drills and heavy manual labour. Section 113 of the Act creates the provision for the building of prison ships. They would be to hold remand prisoners from overcrowding police cells. Last attempted in 1987.

Criminal Justice Act Section 113

10. CAUSING ALARM OR DISTRESS

If you verbally or visibly "insult or abuse" (i.e. shout or gesture) within sight or hearing of a person likely to be caused "alarm or distress" you will commit an offence punishable by up to six months in prison. Displaying any writing or sign which is insulting carries a jail sentence. Slipped in as a last minute amendment it has been attacked as "making even practical jokes illegal".

Criminal Justice Act Section 154

11. CENSORSHIP

Police can arrest individuals and search premises on suspicion without a warrant for 'obscene media' confiscating computer equipment and material. The declared aim is to stop computer-generated child pornography but could be used against anarchist/political literature.

Criminal Justice Act Part VII Section 85

12. STOP AND SEARCH

Police have new blanket stop and search powers without suspicion under certain circumstances - failure to comply can carry up to a six month prison sentence. This can be 24 hours in a specified area where serious violence is expected or 28 days to 'prevent acts of terrorism. An extension of notorious 'sus' laws which led to '81 riots.

Criminal Justice Act Section 60, 81

13. POLICE DNA DATABASE

Officers have the right to take hair or a mouth swab from anyone arrested whether they are charged or not. The information obtained from samples can be kept indefinitely - even if the suspects are found to be innocent - and kept on the world's first national DNA database.

Criminal Justice Act Section 54-59

14. BLANKET SPY CAMERA SURVEILLANCE

The Act gives local authorities powers to install close-circuit surveillance cameras on any land without a licence for which the government granted £5 million to 104 councils in April 1995.

COMPULSORY ID CARDS

Home Secretary Michael Howard announced a Green Paper in May 1995 with voluntary and compulsory 'options' for a national Identity Card. The preferred option is a smart card - a portable dossier of computerised information about the card holder. Set-up costs estimated at half a billion pounds. One company, expected to be Electronic Data Systems, could control all of this information outside of democratic control - data held on computers is completely liquid and can't be regulated against abuse.

PRIVATE (SPONSORED POLITICAL NATIONAL) POLICE FORCE

A review of the 'core functions' of police work is expected in June 1995 to suggest which could be privatised into the unregulated security industry eg Group 4. This is likely to include police cells and beat patrol. Police forces can already accept gifts and money including commercial sponsorship 'in discharge of its functions' thanks to the Police and Magistrates Act 1994. The same new law failed in its proposal to shifting accountability of the heads of Police Authorities to more direct control of the Home Secretary but points to a wish for a politicised national service.

INCREASED POLICE WEAPONRY

CS Gas, a highly toxic battlefield immobilisation gas, banned by international agreement as a chemical warfare agent in January, was given the go-ahead in March 1995 for police trials. The number of patrol cars carrying guns in London will double. This is in addition to the growing police armoury of Heckler and Koch MP5 sub-machine carbines, Smith & Wesson .38 revolvers and the extendable 20-inch side-handled baton.

FORCED LABOUR

The JobSeekers Allowance, due in 1996, will bar people from the social security systems for six months if they break 'official intructions' (JobSeekers' Directive). This could be 'refusing work without good cause' or even not getting your hair cut. Sanctions will apply to all people who do not meet 'labour market conditions'.

CURFEW

Electronic tagging of 'offenders' began in June 1995, with a black box attached to the ankle or wrist, marking the start of new curfew laws in Britain. The Home Secretary hopes it will become the principle community sentence with up to 20,000 orders imposed a year. People will be confined to their homes for between two and 12 hours a day for up to six months. For the first time in the history of criminal justice private security companies are to be given powers to prosecute 'offenders' as well as organise and supervise their sentences.

NEW CRIMINAL JUSTICE ACT?

Paul Condon, head of Metropolitan Police, claimed that villains escape time and time again from Court hearings because of all the rights and protections at their disposal. Honest cop-pers are forced into what Condon dubs 'noble cause corruption' - i.e fabricating evidence to secure prosecution. He has called for a new Criminal Justice Act.

The Internet has had a lot of things written about it, some true, some not. One thing the Internet definitely gives you, though, is the power of communication. The best kind of communication that you can get: instantaneous, anarchic and cheap.

The Internet offers campaigning groups the opportunity to get their message across in the cheapest way imaginable - whether mailing to 30, 300 or 3000 people costs just one local phone call. You can network with people sharing your interests whether they are 6 or 6000 miles away. This means that small groups can work together, and putting many smaller groups in contact with one another gives them the means to share ideas and pool resources. Networking and talking to people is the means for change.

In fact the levels of intercommunication that the Internet offers is so powerful that the US and other governments have begun to start up the legislative engine to rein it in. They have begun to realise the dangers to their power structures that highly adaptive networked groups can be. Groups with no discernible leaders makes it difficult for governments to combat, coerce and control them. The Internet is power.



If we seize the technology and know-how before the governments of the world discover how to wield it, we have the means and the power at our disposal to control our own lives. Governments are highly bureaucratic organisations that are stuffed with middle managers and hierarchies that are resistant to change and to new ideas. In previous times this gave Governments the advantage in controlling the people by being able to understand, control and filter information, however with the age of the information revolution these forms of outdated control mean nothing. Governments realise this and that is why they are beginning to dismantle the old structures, with privatisation, *qangoç* (where government departments are run as autonomous organisations), outsourcing (contracting out government duties) and extremely powerful computer systems, (eg the super database that will hold details of everyone in the UK on their NHS, social security, banking, criminal and driving details). This is also

blurring the lines between government and business, such that the needs of business, are the needs of the government and vice versa.



You only need to look to Thailand where their government has implemented the biggest cataloguing computer system on any group of people ever. Besides holding details about an individual's social security, banking, criminal and driving details it also contains their ancestry, their education and their working history. This unprecedented computerisation of a people gives the government a huge advantage for suppression and control. Not only that, but once you have a unique identity number for each individual you can use what are called relational databases to track their friends, political affiliations, cash flow, in fact absolutely everything.

The Internet offers the chance to escape the all seeing eyes of governments through the use of a system that is a security forces' nightmare. Messages sent over the Internet are auto-rerouted, in other words nobody can tell which paths they take to reach their destination. Because space is not a limiting force on the Internet, an e-mail to a friend in Scotland from London might be routed across Europe to Australia via Finland and back. Coupled with encryption that can take days and weeks to break, listening in and tapping the information is not easy.

The Internet is not a means onto itself. It is a very powerful tool that gives us the facility to disseminate information, talk to one another and create the means to challenge the authority of governments and become agents of change ourselves. If we do not embrace this opportunity now it will be seized by government and used upon us. A major tool for change is in our hands and it is up to us to make sure it is used for the benefit of every individual.

To get Internetted you will need:

- A relatively good PC (486 if you want to use the World Wide Web) or Macintosh
- Pretty good modem, above 9600 speed is the best
- An Internet Point of Presence (ie a company that will connect you and your modem up)
- Comms software (usually from above)
- Patience

McPolice on the way?

AVON AND SOMERSET POLICE

Imagine the scene - a road traffic accident on the A4. A drink-driver has knocked down and seriously injured a pedestrian. A forensic examination vehicle arrives to take evidence. The victim, blood streaming down their face, peers up and can faintly make out a logo on the side of the police van - "Threshers, Your Number One Off-Licence."

Threshers became the first commercial company to sponsor the police service under a new Act which will change the public face of policing. Section 23 of the Police and Magistrates Courts Act 1994 states "A police authority may, in connection with the discharge of any of its functions, accept gifts and money (including) commercial sponsorship."

Threshers have calculated that the controversy about sponsorship would be good for business! Eagle Star and RMI are interested in doing business and Nuclear Electric have followed up with a joint deal on a communications centre for the use of Avon & Somerset police (it's empty at present on standby for a nuclear emergency).

SchNEWS contacted Avon and Somerset Police to see just how far they are selling out. The switchboard was enthusiastic - "*oh we are always looking for sponsorship*" - and put us through to Inspector Bob Lewis (Community Liaison). Bob's field is car crime which he admitted "*isn't very sexy*" but added: "*this is an aside but we have a very good relationship with the press and if we send out a press release it usually ends up as a story if you follow what I mean.*" He put us through to a very helpful Penny Hallett (sponsorship committee) on the promise of a very good deal to cover the South-West. "*We are looking for £50,000 for a radio advertising campaign on crime prevention using a 60's song*" explained Penny, who on prompting started singing the sad jingle:

"let's hang on to what we've got...don't let go...you've got a lot!"

SchNEWS explained that they were look-

ing for something a little more tasty. "*Well with the new Act basically the world's your oyster*" spouted Penny. "*You could sponsor us for anything at all - its only limited by your imagination.*" Would it be possible to sponsor a police operation, say "Operation Coca-Cola?" "*yes but I suppose it depends on what it was. Maybe not an armed operation*" There is a code of conduct, of course. The only hard rule is that gifts loans and sponsorship should not exceed a maximum equivalent value of 1% of force budget. The rest of the carefully-worded guideline tries to tip-toe through the obvious paradox of police accepting money from business - like it "will not be accepted where there is a risk of offending the integrity of the police." I think most people would agree Avon & Somerset have exceeded that already....

D.N... Eh?

The world's first national DNA database is here in Britain - thanks to the Criminal Justice Act! The new laws give the police powers to forcibly take hair or a mouth swab from anyone arrested wherever they are charged or not. The information obtained from samples can be kept indefinitely, even if suspects are found to be innocent. This applies not just to rapists and murderers but also to those suspected of petty offences.

Section 59 of the CJA redefines non-intimacy to include mouth searches. Most people would consider having a police superintendent poking about in their mouth pretty intimate.

Police hope to have about 135,000 tests on computer at a cost of £5 million in the first year alone, and extend it to all recordable offences by the end of the century.

Seen with the introduction of compulsory ID card and the growth of blanket video surveillance, the DNA database is yet another attempt to log, document and control. The Government is steadily eroding the rights of each and every one of us, using the pretext of the fight against crime to push through increasingly restrictive laws.

- One clueless copper admitted he quoted the sections of the Act relating to illegal rave parties when arresting some Kent Hunt Sabs!

ARRESTOMETER ROUND-UP

Seven months into the first season of the Criminal Justice Act and Hunt Sabs have made a flying start to top the Arrestometer. However with only nine convictions (most subject to appeal) and over 60 cases dropped, one commented "The CJA is simply not working and we anticipate there will be more acquittals, more charges dropped, and that those police forces who seek to use the act in an aggressive and oppressive way such as Kent and Northamptonshire will be facing a hefty bill for damages with precious little to show in the way of convictions."

Somewhat surprisingly Football Fans take second spot with 44. Footie fans have always had a bum deal when it comes to the police but it seems they are perhaps some of the more unlikely victims of legislation that the powers that be would have us believe only affects travellers, ravers, hunt sabs and road protestors. A coachload of Cardiff City Fans were stopped, searched and arrested - under Section 60 which wasn't even law at the time - then released without charge after seven and a half hours in police cells. Eric Cantona's tormentor Matthew Simmons was charged under Section 154 which states that if you verbally or visibly "insult or abuse" (ie shout or gesture) within sight or hearing of a person likely to be caused "alarm or distress" you will commit an offence punishable by up to six months in prison. While we might not shed tears for Simmons, like a lot of the CJA this clause is incredibly vague, especially applied to footie fans who spend the whole game shouting, gesturing and winding up players and other spectators! Lastly, seven lucky fans have been nicked under another clause that makes it an offence to sell on a match ticket even at face value!

Road Protestors are up there with 18 all charged with "aggravated trespass". Four Earth First!ers nicked within 24 hours of the Act becoming law for climbing a Wimpey crane were given a one year conditional discharge and fined £50 costs. All other cases are still pending.

Travellers and Tree Defenders are neck and neck with 11. Two people at Huddersfield trying to stop trees being felled for road-widening have had their charges dropped while in Surrey charges have been changed to breaking local traffic regulations!

Gathering any statistics on travellers is always incredibly hard but we know the authorities are using the threat of the CJA to move people on as the eviction merry-go-round picks up full steam and places to park up become fewer and fewer.

At the bottom of the table No Live Exports demonstrators are struggling with just 3 arrests, although they're being nicked under the Public Order Act as if its going out of fashion - nearly 1,000 this year so far.

Statistics are crap - how do we measure the abolition of the right to silence, the set-

ting up of the world's first national DNA database, the new stop and search clause, restrictive new police bail conditions, children's prisons, the threats and intimidation of use of the Act? The Arrestometer just gives a rough idea of whats going on round the country.

In some respects more worrying than all of this is the widespread use of the 1986 Public Order Act. After the end of the year long Miners Strike and the Battle of the Beanfield spirits were low and this Act passed without much opposition and is now being used as an arrest catch-all, especially at the ports taking live animal exports. Crap arrests abound, hundreds at Brightingsea and Shoreham alone where at the latter a woman was jailed for seven days for breaking her bail conditions and at Essex the police have threatened to arrest anybody under the Act for demonstrating without permission. We can't sit back and let the powers-that-be get away with it.

CARRY ON DEFYING!

BYE BYE DOLE?

While cronies in big business get huge pay rises, the government is planning another squeeze on the unemployed. Unemployment Benefit and Income Support are to be replaced by a single unified benefit to be known as the Job Seekers Allowance.

The Job Seekers Allowance (JSA) will impose stricter conditions for the receipt of benefits. Claimants will be obliged to sign a 'contract' setting out the steps they intend to take to find work. The employment service will have new discretionary powers to compel claimants to take specific actions to 'make themselves more employable.' Such actions may include having to attend a course or join various 'training' or workfare schemes where claimants will have to work for their benefits, or they even may go as far as directing claimants to have a haircut to make themselves "more presentable to prospective employers." Failure to comply with such directives could mean a complete withdrawal of benefit leaving people with nothing to live on. This can only lead to a dramatic increase in the numbers of people becoming homeless and destitute.

With 26 people chasing every vacancy in Brighton alone the JSA is simply another vindictive measure to blame the unemployed for the government's own economic failures. It would also seem yet another attempt to scapegoat and harass those people, who facing mass unemployment, have sought to develop alternative and diverse lifestyles that are not dependent on endless work and consumption. After government attempts to criminalise us with the CJA they now want to take away our meagre benefits unless we conform!

With people desperate to find any work, whatever the pay or conditions, employers will be able to put the pressure on. Its up to all groups campaigning against the CJA to forge links with workers and claimants and stop the JSA in its tracks.

BAIL NIGHTMARE

Faced with the increasing determination of protesters, stricter bail conditions are being used to stop people fighting back. Two people nicked at the No M77 Pollok Free State in Glasgow spent six days in prison after initially refusing bail conditions which stated they were "not to approach obstruct or interfere with any Wimpey Construction Site." Their crime? Taking out fence poles and damaging cement. A mother was recently sent to prison for a week after breaking bail conditions at Shoreham and an Earth Firster in Manchester nicked twice under the CJA, has been told "not to enter any construction site".

At Twyford Down 76 protesters had injunctions on their risking 6 months in prison if they went on any work sites. At the No M11 Link Road campaign magistrates were putting everyone on appalling bail conditions after being arrested for such heinous crimes as "criminal damage to a piece of string". **These restrictive bail conditions are just another attempt to keep us quiet and out of the way - ACT UP**

PRISON FOR KIDS

Thanks to the CJA, plans to build five 'Secure Training Centres' for 200 children aged between 12 and 14 have been given the go-ahead.

The prisons have been condemned by almost everyone involved in juvenile justice as doing nothing to stop crime and inevitably leading to more crime and child abuse. But hey, if Michael Howard can get a few votes from mind-numbed bigots then its worth it.

Local authorities and social workers have refused to have anything to do with the new prisons so they are to be run, for a profit, by private security firms - Group 4 are keen to make some cash out of it.

Under the proposed guidelines the children will have none of the protections against abuse they have in children's homes. They can be forcibly strip-searched by a single member of staff with no one else present during the search. All mail can be read and censored. Family visits can be stopped at any time. And just to make sure no one finds out too much about what's going on in these places the Home Secretary has to give permission for a child to communicate with anyone - or for any outsider to visit these centres. Inevitably bullying, abuse, self-mutilation and suicides will be common in these institutions. The children who survive their time inside will come out more abused and embittered and more likely to reoffend then ever.

The CJA is going to put lots of people in prison for dancing, protesting, staying silent and lots more. The fact that the politicians, Tory and Labour, are even prepared to scapegoat children for society's problems shows just how sick they are. We must defend and support anyone put in prison under the CJA - and that includes the children.

and Finally

Home Office thumbs up for Group 4 Riot Squads at immigration detention centres and Group 4 have already made representations to take over the running of what they term "police custody suites". That means police cells to you and me - see you all in the nick!

AIMS: To link local/regional groups opposed to the Criminal Justice Act and keep information on actions and significant events flowing. The Network is made up of 80+ independent local groups who are trying to wake their communities up to the dangers of the Act. The Network also includes special interest groups which are being specifically targeted by the CJA ie squatters, travellers, free-party organisers, hunt sabs, road protesters etc.

The general aims of the Network are diverse and vary from group to group but overall, the idea is: to empower, to help save a dying democracy and to make people realise that they can be part of the solution by standing up for what they believe in. Most groups are united by a common appreciation that non-violent direct action is a vital key to reclaiming our democratic voice. Above all, many people in the anti-CJA campaign have learned that protest and politics can be fun. Let's try and keep it that way!

Accordingly, we aim to secure the equal rights and liberties of everyone, individuals and groups, insofar as they do not infringe the rights and liberties of others, and oppose any abuse or excessive use of power by the state against its people. We also recognise that the erosion of civil liberties often begins with attacks on the rights of those who are marginalised within society - such attacks undermine the rights of us all.

As a pressure group we work to protect and extend human rights and civil liberties by campaigning at local and national level. There are local and student Liberty groups in many parts of the country. Our legal team pursues test cases through the British and European courts. We co-ordinate a network of volunteer solicitors. We provide free written information about rights issues. We lobby parliament, providing facts, figures and briefings for MPs, giving evidence to government enquiries and select committees and draft amendments to proposals and parliamentary bills. We act as a watchdog, analysing and commenting on the implications of proposed changes to legislation, and alerting the public and the media to any dangers and threats. We research and publish reports on a wide range of human rights issues and have an extensive civil liberties library used by journalists, researchers and members of the public.

Liberty is currently running a public order monitoring project to monitor the use of the Criminal Justice and Public Order Act (1994). The Lammas meadows of Leyton and Walthamstow were given to the people of the two parishes earlier this century in exchange for their rights of common grazing. Since then, they have come under the administration of a quango called the 'Lea Valley Regional Park Authority' whose first act was to attempt to dig the marshes up for gravel extraction! The NLLDC was formed to oppose the continuing encroachment of 'leisure facilities' (such as livery stabling, car-parks, cinemas) onto our open land. We use many campaigning techniques, including lobbying councillors, letter-writing and occasionally direct action. We also organise picnics, walks and occasional festivals on the marshes to encourage people to use and enjoy them and to join us in campaigning for their preservation. We are allied with No New Lea Valley Roads Campaign.

AIMS: 1. To stop a major road being built up the Lea Valley to serve as an "Eastern By-Pass" for the M25 orbital motorway. To oppose Waltham Forest Council's proposals for a "Relief Road" from Stratford to Walthamstow to bypass Leyton.

In the late 1960's two options were offered by the department of Transport for the M11 motorway extension; one through the Roding Valley and Leytonstone to Hackney Wick, and the other through the Lea Valley. The present M11 Link Road route was chosen because it was cheaper, but the alternative - connecting Blackwall Tunnel and Stratford to the M25 - was kept open as an option for the future. A motorway by stealth is now being imposed on the valley. Most of the Lea Valley route is already in place (the A1055 North-South Route). Despite the scheme's rejection following a recent lengthy Public Inquiry, Waltham Forest Borough Council continue to promote the construction of the "Leyton Relief Road." This would complete the route except for a 1.5 mile gap on Walthamstow Marshes, which are a designated Nature Reserve, containing a Bird Sanctuary and two SSSI's. The NNLVRC is an umbrella for a number of local interest groups - including the Southern Lea Valley Federation, Residents against Traffic, Lammas Lands Defence Committee, Friends of the Earth and the No M11 Link Road Campaign - all of which are opposed to motorway construction in the Lea Valley.
